

Ph.D. Program Entrance Requirements

Post-BA Entrance Requirements

1. **Undergraduate GPA** demonstrating academic excellence (usually above 3.5 on a 4-point scale).
2. **GRE scores** indicate strong potential for success in a rigorous academic program.
3. **Work, volunteer, or research experience** in counseling or related fields, with one or more letters of recommendation addressing applicant's emotional maturity and developmentally appropriate helping skills.
4. **Research experience** in counseling or related fields, including McNair, SORP or SERP programs.

Note: If you have an advanced degree in another field (e.g., Educational Psychology, law, business, divinity) and lack the counseling practicum necessary for application to the post-MA PhD program, you should apply to the post-BA Ph.D. program.

Post-MA: Entrance Requirements

1. **M.A., M.Ed. or M.S. or Ph.D.** in Counseling or a related field which includes counseling practicum experiences.
2. **Demonstrated academic skills**, (e.g., GRE, GPA in graduate and undergraduate courses)
3. **Research experience** and interests in counseling and related areas of psychology
4. **Work, volunteer, or practicum experience** in counseling or related fields, with one or more letters of recommendation addressing applicant's emotional maturity and counseling skills.
